- Appellate Jurisdiction
- Determine whether the law was applied correctly by the **District Court**
- Losing side can appeal a decision based on unfair conduct, misapplication of law, or a violation of the Constitution
- 3 Judges on a panel, no jury
- Decisions are the final for the majority of federal cases in the **United States**
- "En Banc" A special procedure where all the judges of a circuit hear a case
